Ice Show rehearsals for all courts and solos and scheduled sessions for all skaters will be from Monday, November 1, 2010 to Friday, December 10, 2010. Courts are groups of skaters who are choreographed to skate together in the show. Each group will be made according to skill level and age. Each court will have two rehearsals each week. Younger skaters may be grouped together in the show based on size as well as skating level. While we endeavor to make court and solo rehearsals as convenient for everyone as possible, we cannot guarantee that these rehearsal times will be the same as the skater's regular session times.

Picture Day and time will be determined.

There will be no skating for regular sessions on the day of the Ice Show, Saturday, December 11, 2010.

Ice Show Practice Schedule will be posted mid October 2010.

Each skater will have a costume made to fit their performance. Costumes will be rented and are the property of the Academy and following the Ice Show, must be returned to us.

Skaters who qualify for a solo, duet, or trio are responsible for getting their own costume that suits the music chosen.

Every skater will be responsible for purchasing a specified pair of footed tights and will be responsible for their own hair and make-up (details to follow at a later date).

The cost of producing the Ice Show includes ice rental, dressing room rental, lighting and sound equipment, music, bleachers and installation, props, costume rentals and so on. SKATERS MEASUREMENTS:

Please fill this chart out accurately.

<p>Remember the following for taking Measurements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • VERY IMPORTANT: DO NOT ADD OR SUBTRACT from your measurements. Measure exactly as instructed below. • When taking measurements REMOVE all bulky clothes • Hold the tape taut, not tight, against the body with the skater standing straight at rest with feet flat on the floor. • Pants must be at waistline so that the pant is not drooping between the legs (this will alter the girth measurement) <p>Guidelines for Measurements and Important Landmarks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can mark the waistline by TYING A STRING AROUND at the navel or thinnest part of the body (for measurements # 3, 4, 6 & 10). • The shoulder bone is at the dimple that forms when the arm is raised above the head (for measurements # 5, 7 & 8). • The wrist bone is the prominent bone that is in line with the baby finger (for measurements # 7). 	<p>Measurement (Measure to the closest half or whole inch)</p>
<p>1. HEIGHT (If skates on take 3" off height)</p>	
<p>2. CHEST (around fullest part)</p>	
<p>3. WAIST (at the navel or thinnest part of the body-can use string around waist as a guideline)</p>	
<p>4. HIPS (around fullest part -this is approx. 8" to 9" below waist-can use string around waist as a guideline)</p>	
<p>5. SHOULDER TO SHOULDER (from shoulder bone to shoulder bone across the back)</p>	
<p>6. ARMPIT TO WAIST (from the armpit to side waistline- can use string around waist as a guideline)</p>	
<p>7. SLEEVE LENGTH (from shoulder bone to 1" past the wrist bone)</p>	
<p>8. GIRTH (shoulder bone down the front through the legs up the back to opposite shoulder bone)</p>	
<p>9. INSEAM (level of the top of the inside leg to heel of shoe or skate) – BOYS ONLY</p>	
<p>10. OUTSEAM (from side waistline at string to heel of shoe or skate) – BOYS ONLY</p>	
<p>11. CLOTHING SIZE</p>
